## Cape Cod Bridges Program

### What is happening?

A live virtual public information meeting will be hosted on Zoom and an in-person Open House will be hosted in Bourne. The purpose of these meetings is to provide updates on the Cape Cod Bridges Program. At these events, there will be information on the status of the Program, project funding and federal grants, scoping of the Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) under the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), and next steps. All views and comments submitted in response to these events will be reviewed and considered to the maximum extent possible.

### How will this affect you?

The Program will include the replacement of the Bourne and Sagamore bridges, new connections to the local roadway network, and improved multimodal accommodations within the Cape Cod Canal area.
