

The meeting of the Cape Cod Commission was called to order on Thursday, April 16, 2009 at 3:00 p.m. in the Assembly of Delegates Chambers in Barnstable, MA. Roll was called and a quorum was not established.

■ **CHAPTER A—ENABLING REGULATIONS GOVERNING REVIEW OF DEVELOPMENTS OF REGIONAL IMPACT**
