Sagamore Line Reinforcement Project, Western Segment Phases I & II Sandwich, Massachusetts

August 28, 2015

Dear Neighbor,

Colonial Gas Company d/b/a National Grid will soon begin the construction of the Sagamore Line Reinforcement Project, Western Segment Phases I and II. We anticipate a construction start time of mid- to late-September.

The following is key project and construction information.

About the Project: National Grid will install a 20-inch gas transmission main for over 4.4 miles on the north side of Service Road in Sandwich between Route 130 and Chase Road. Phase I will go from Route 130, east to Quaker Meeting House Road, and Phase II will go from Quaker Meeting House Rd, east to Chase Road – see enclosed maps. The purpose of this project is to maintain reliability and meet the growing demand for natural gas on Cape Cod. The project has been reviewed and approved by the Energy Facilities Siting Board and the Cape Cod Commission, and has received necessary permits from the Town of Sandwich.

Construction: Construction of the project is anticipated for completion in Fall/Winter 2016. As a neighbor, you will see our construction crews and vehicles traveling through the area. The work will progress along the routes listed with crews located in a given area anywhere from a few days to a few weeks at a time. Lane restrictions may be necessary to support construction activities, and signage will be clearly posted to alert motorists.

Visual Mitigation: National Grid is committed to providing visual mitigation per our visual mitigation program and supplemental plan as presented to the community. In late-March qualified abutters were mailed a response form to indicate interest in initiating the visual mitigation process. For those who completed the forms, thank you for your response, and our visual mitigation team will be in touch immediately following the tree clearing phase of construction, anticipated for October. If you are a qualified abutter who has **not** yet responded, please contact our dedicated Visual Mitigation Hotline at **781-586-8890** and a project representative will be happy to pick up the enclosed form or coordinate otherwise. Visual mitigation will occur in phases as construction advances on the project.
