The Cape Cod Commission will hold a public hearing **Thursday, July 28, 2016, 5:00 p.m. at the Harwich Town Hall, Griffin Room, 732 Main Street, Harwich, MA, 02645** for the purpose of conducting Development of Regional Impact (DRI) review for the following Project pursuant to Sections 12(i) and 13(b) of the Cape Cod Commission Act and Section 2(d) of the Cape Cod Commission's *Enabling Regulations Governing Developments of Regional Impact*. The Project is a mandatory DRI pursuant to Section 2(d)(i) of said Enabling Regulations, and the Secretary of the Massachusetts Executive Office of Energy and Environmental Affairs has issued a Certificate on the Project's Single Environmental Impact Report under the Massachusetts Environmental Policy Act. This notice is published pursuant to Section 5 of the Cape Cod Commission Act.

Project Name: Harwich Comprehensive Wastewater Management Plan (CWMP)
Project Applicant: Town of Harwich
Project Description: A town-wide, long-term, multi-phased wastewater management program to reduce nutrient loading to coastal waters; improve, restore and maintain water quality within various water resources; and meet anticipated total maximum daily loads (TMDLs) for estuaries/embayments along Nantucket Sound and Pleasant Bay.
