**Project Description:** Proposed habitat restoration and reestablishment of tidal flow to the 1,100-acre Herring River estuary system and floodplain. Proposed restoration actions include reconfiguration of the Chequessett Neck Road dike and tide gates, replacement of additional upstream culverts, addition of other upstream tidal control structures, wetlands restoration, and flood-proofing measures to low-lying roadways, structures, and private properties.

No substantive presentations will be made, no testimony will be taken and no substantive action will be taken regarding this project at this hearing.
