

Dear Mr. Niedzwiecki,

On behalf of the citizens of Sandwich, I am requesting that you convene an important public meeting in which said citizens will be allowed to express their views on the purchase of the so-called "Golden Triangle" land by the Board of Selectmen.

It is my belief that you keep close watch on similar and other issues around Cape Cod and thus are familiar with the project which has been vigorously protested since its announcement last June. Throughout the past seven months citizens have asked questions which have remained unanswered. We have offered countless reasons why this particular project is definitely not in the best interests of either Sandwich or Cape Cod. All input, protests and questions posed to the Board have been ignored, received rude and arrogant public condemnation in the newspapers by two Board Members and been subjected to what can only be called a temper tantrum by a third Board member, railing against "citizens who come before the Board complaining about what we do." As a matter of fact, the entire treatment of citizens clearly shows an arrogant annoyance and disdain and a fundamental denial of their rights. Further, the fact that this project was only announced seven months before a Purchase and Sale Agreement was signed has become a cause of suspicion as to how long prior to the announcement quiet meetings were being held to work out details of the whole project before the public had any knowledge.

An open and well publicized opportunity for citizens to present their arguments as to why we will be requesting that your Commission seriously consider refusing to sign on to the Land Agreement which is essential if this project is to be finalized. It will, of course, be the opportunity for those in favor to present their positions also.

We will look forward to your reply and appreciate your interest and concern in our request.
