The Cape Cod Commission will conduct a public hearing on **Thursday, August 20, 2015 at 3:00 p.m. in the First District Courthouse, Assembly of Delegates Chambers, Route 6A, Barnstable, MA.** The following project has been referred to the Cape Cod Commission as a mandatory Development of Regional Impact (DRI) and was previously limited in scope to certain Regional Policy Plan issue areas by decision dated January 22, 2015. This project is being reviewed and considered for Limited DRI approval. At this hearing the Commission will consider approval as a Limited Development of Regional Impact and adoption of a draft written decision. This notice is being published as required by Section 5 of the Cape Cod Commission Act.
