Massachusetts Department of Transportation (MassDOT) Canal Area Transportation Study: The Cape Cod Canal Area Transportation Study seeks to identify existing and future multimodal transportation deficiencies and needs around the Cape Cod Canal area in the towns of Bourne and Sandwich. The study also describes the development and analysis of a full range of transportation alternatives including highway and non-highway improvements and alternatives that improve access for all modes of transportation. Commission staff will give an update on the status of the Canal Area Transportation Study, and then the Cape Cod Joint Transportation Committee will discuss the study. *Steve Tupper, Cape Cod Commission Transportation Planner*

2019-2023 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Development: The TIP is a recommended list of transportation projects to be advertised and eventually constructed using Massachusetts Department of Transportation, Federal Highway Administration and Federal Transit Administration funding for Federal Fiscal Years 2019 to 2023 (October 1, 2018 to September 30, 2023). Cape Cod Commission staff will give a presentation explaining the process of developing the TIP. The Joint Transportation Committee will discuss the projects that could be included in the 2019-2023 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) and may recommend that the Metropolitan Planning Organization release the DRAFT Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for public comment. - *Steve Tupper, Cape Cod Commission Transportation Planner*

Federal Fiscal Year 2019 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) Development: The UPWP is a list of transportation planning projects scheduled for funding and implementation as outlined in the Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2019 (October 1, 2018 to September 30, 2019) UPWP document. Cape Cod Commission staff will give a presentation outlining potential planning projects to be included in the FFY 2019 UPWP.
