Dear Administrator Mello:

Under the Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21st Century (MAP-21) Act, I am required to coordinate with the Governors of New Hampshire, Rhode Island, and Connecticut to designate recipients of grant funds in Urbanized Areas (UZA) that include communities in both Massachusetts and these adjoining states. These recipients will have the legal authority to receive and dispense these federal grant funds.
