



Cape Cod Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) endorses the TIP Amendment

The *Cape Cod Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) AMENDMENT for Federal Fiscal Years (FFY) 2013–2016*, was unanimously endorsed by the MPO on Monday, March 4, 2013. The TIP Amendment for FFY 2013-2016 projects will now be included in the State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP), and with approvals, complete designs, and/or all permitting, the \$36.9 million in 2013 projects may now move forward. The projects in year 2013 of the TIP Amendment are summarized below:
