## FUNDING

Funding comes from a combination of state and federal sources, typically in the range of \$900,000 per year.



## TYPICAL PROJECTS

Typical projects include data collection efforts, Living Streets studies, safety studies, bicycle planning initiatives, and coastal resiliency projects. Planning efforts are designed to address safety and congestion concerns for all transportation modes, including vehicle, transit, bicycle, and pedestrian travel.
