Of the more than **181,000 structures** on Cape Cod,
less than 10% are **100+ years old**



and **fewer than 300 structures**
date back to **1716 or earlier.**

Only about 6.5% of Cape Cod's structures have been
inventoried by the Massachusetts Cultural Resource
Information System (MACRIS).



More than 40% of Cape Cod's MACRIS-inventoried buildings that are 100+ years old are **not protected** by any historic designation.
