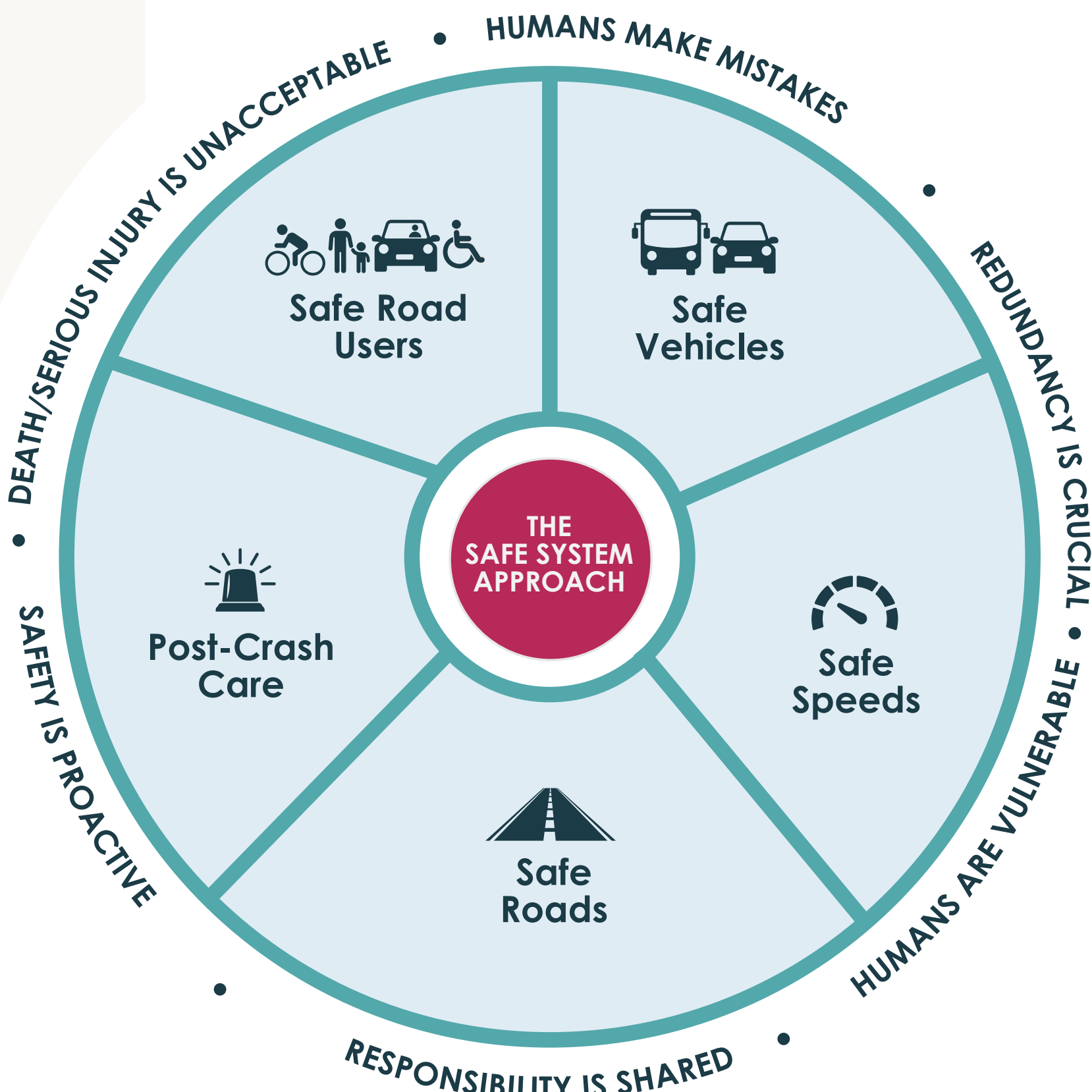

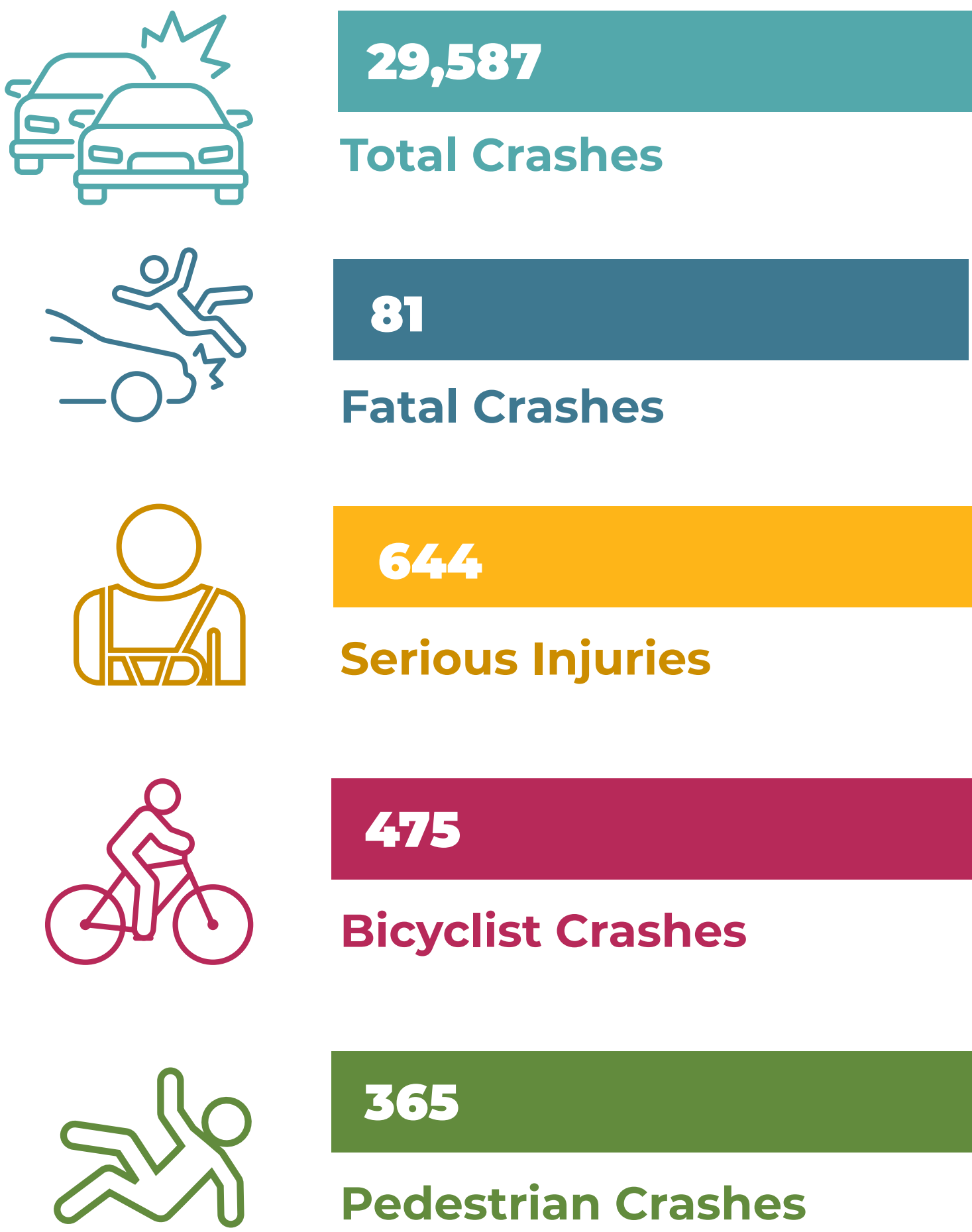
Why is Vision Zero Important to Me?
