 6. **TIP Project Updates:** Massachusetts Department of Transportation ("MassDOT") staff will provide updates on the status of 2020-2024 and potential future TIP projects.
 7. **Federal Fiscal Years (October 1 – September 30) 2021-2025 TIP Development:** Staff will discuss updates on the cost and readiness of projects across Cape Cod that are eligible to be funded through the TIP and the MPO may vote on a list of projects for staff to include in a draft 2021-2025 TIP.
 8. **Federal Fiscal Year 2021 (October 1, 2020 – September 30, 2021) Unified Planning Work Program ("UPWP") Development:** Staff will review tasks and studies for the 2021 UPWP and the Cape Cod Metropolitan Organization ("MPO") may vote on a list of tasks and studies for staff to include in a draft 2021 UPWP.
 9. **Reports:** Massachusetts Department of Transportation, Cape Cod Regional Transit Authority, and Cape Cod Commission staff will report on recent and upcoming transportation initiatives across Cape Cod.
