(TIP) DEVELOPING THE TRANSPORTATION CAPITAL PLAN FOR CAPE COD



The Cape Cod Metropolitan Planning Organization's (MPO) transportation capital plan, the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), lists major transportation projects planned in the next five years.



FUNDING

Funding comes from a combination of state and federal sources, and totals more than \$375 million over the five-year plan.



TYPICAL PROJECTS

Typical projects include reconstruction of existing intersections or roadways, construction of new multi-use paths, and purchase of new buses to support regional bus service. Projects are designed to address safety and congestion concerns for all transportation modes, including vehicle, transit, bicycle, and pedestrian travel.
