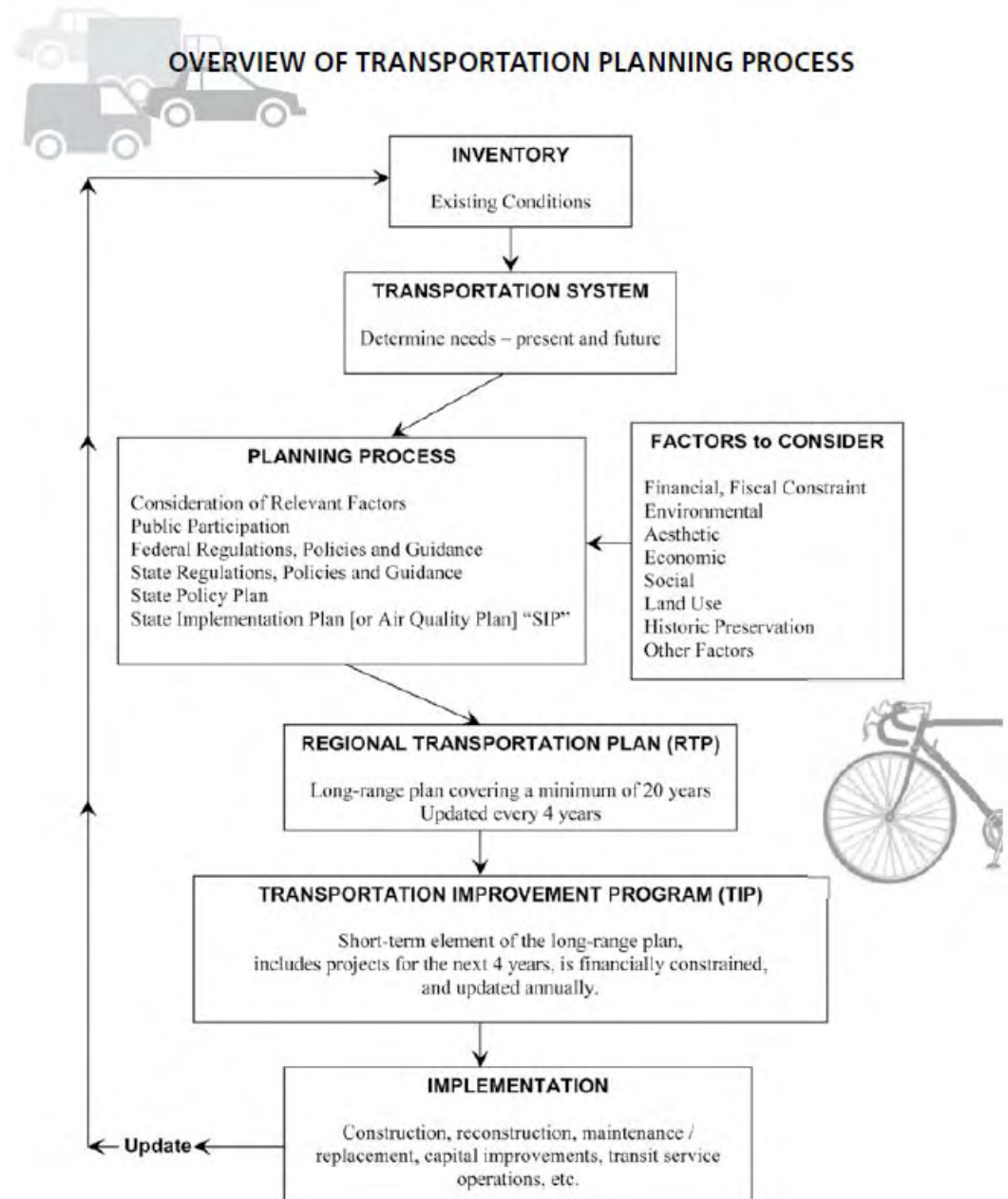

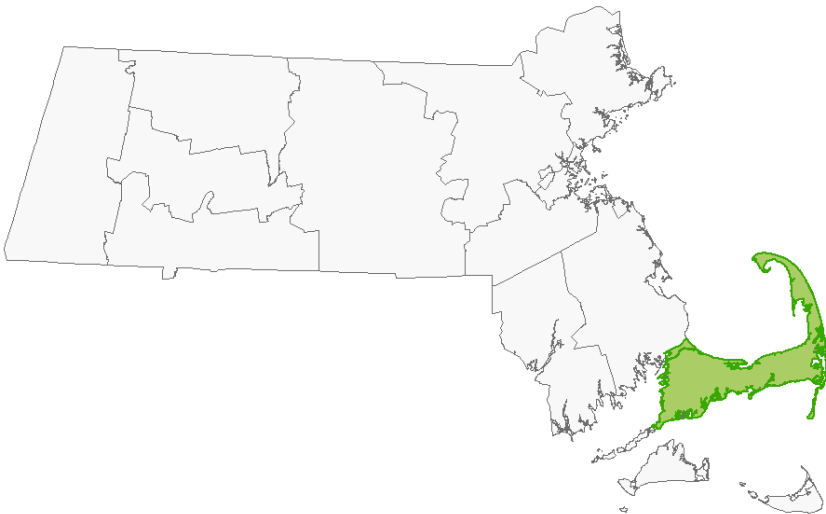

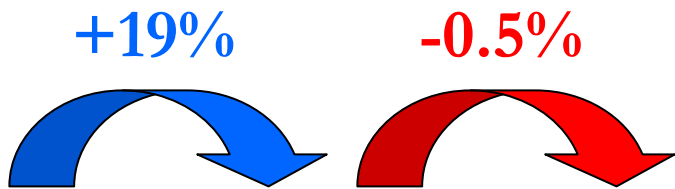
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Each year, about \$10,000,000 is dispensed from the state to Cape Cod through the TIP program.





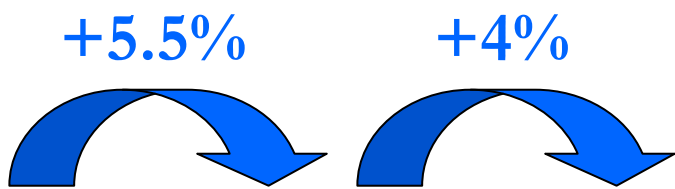

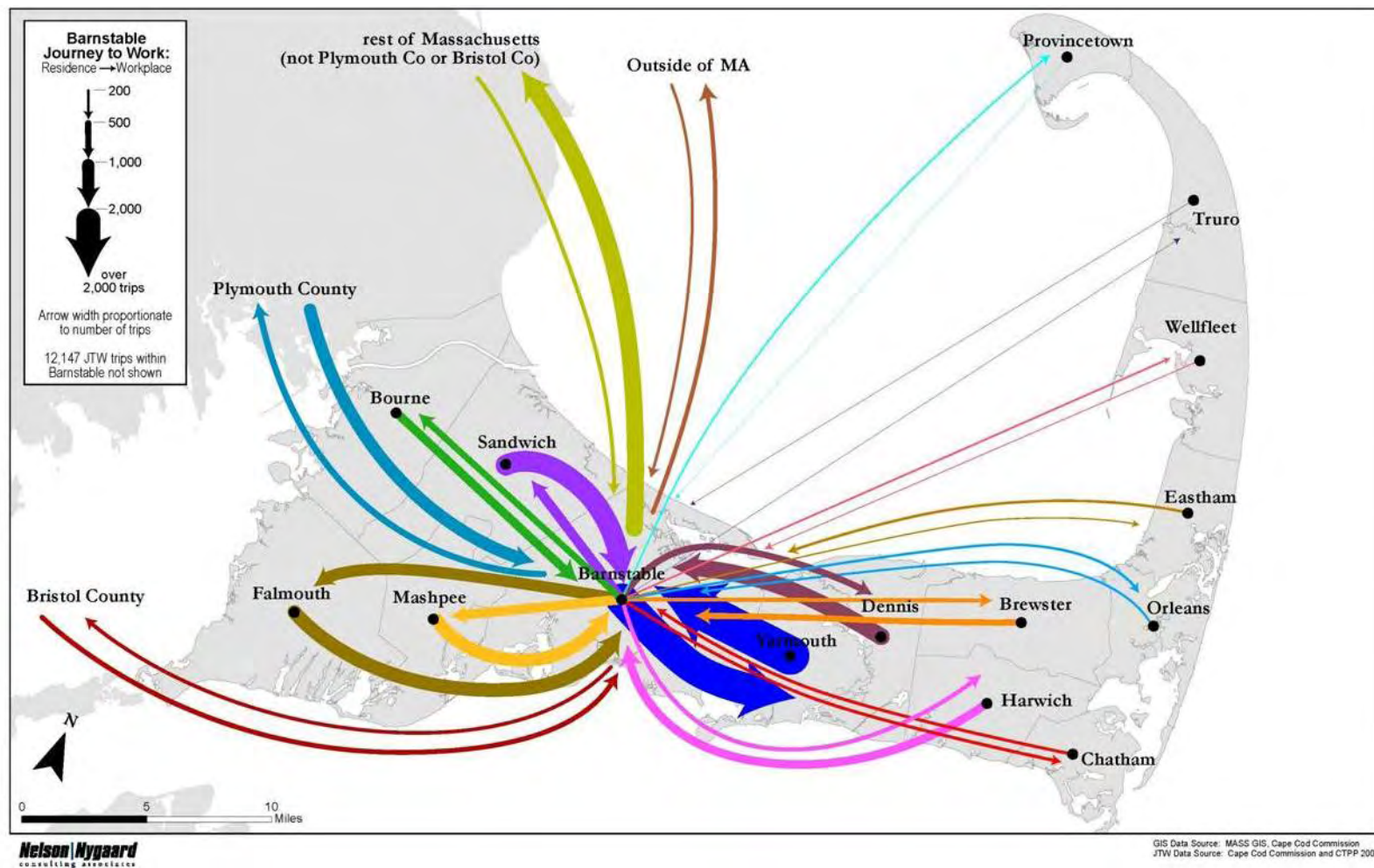

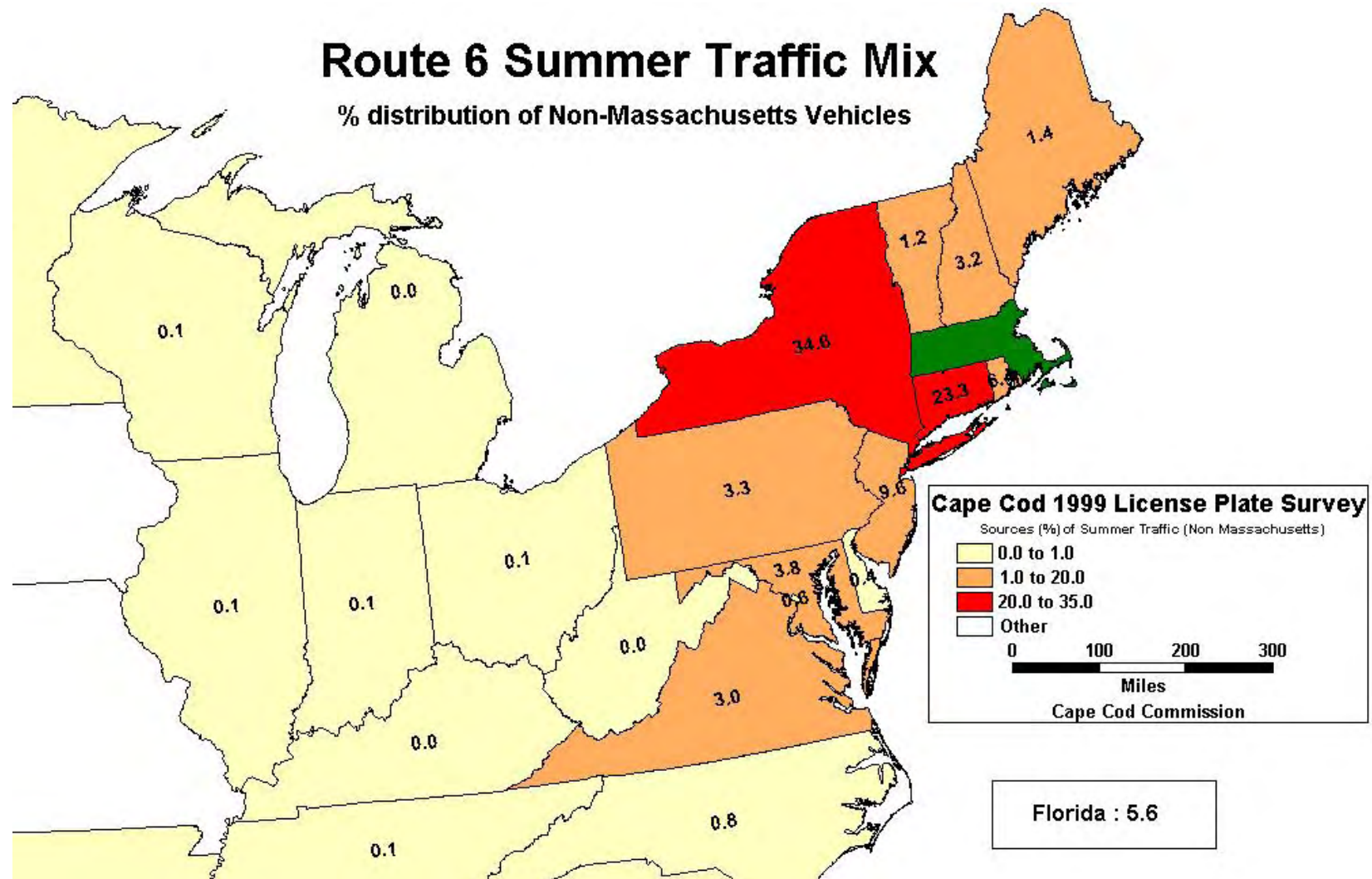

## Journey to Work Data To and From the Town of Barnstable







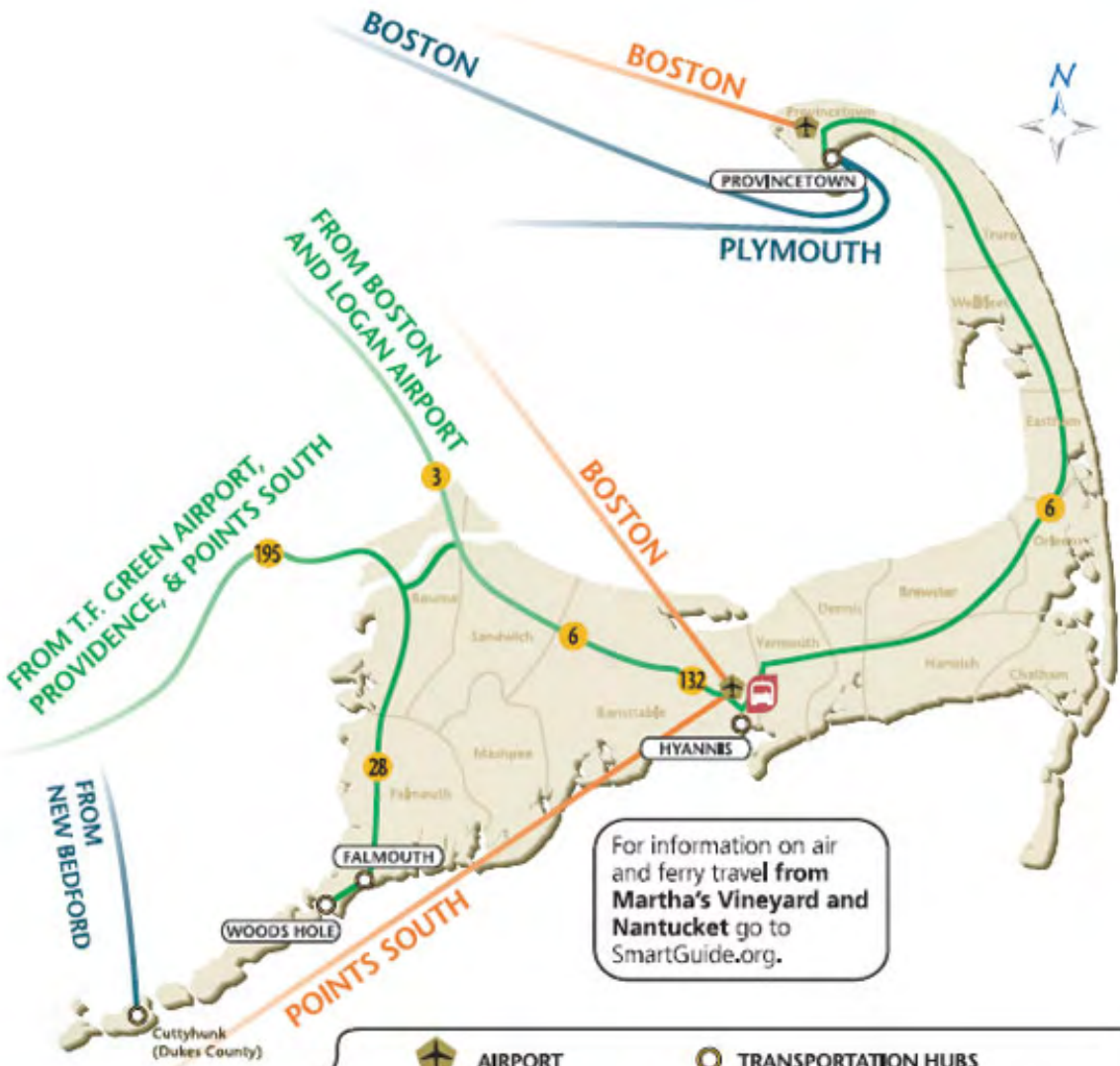

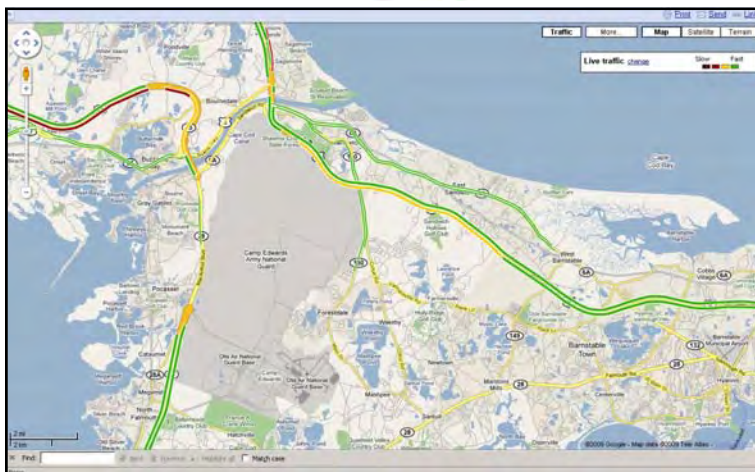

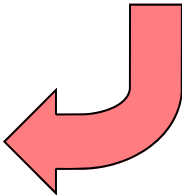


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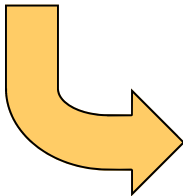


10-Year Annual Average Growth Rate: 1999-2009



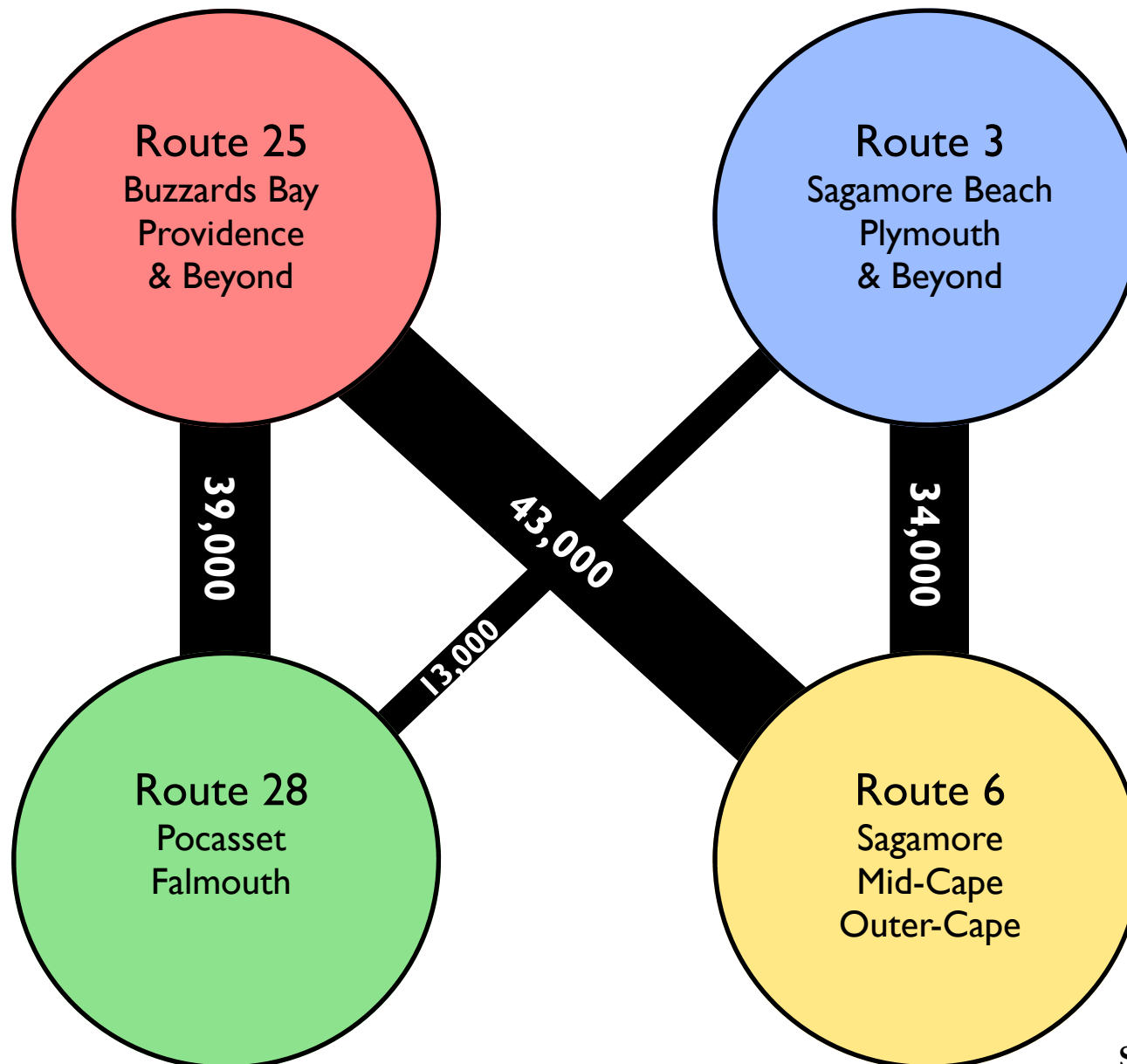
Over the last ten years, Cape-wide traffic has decreased

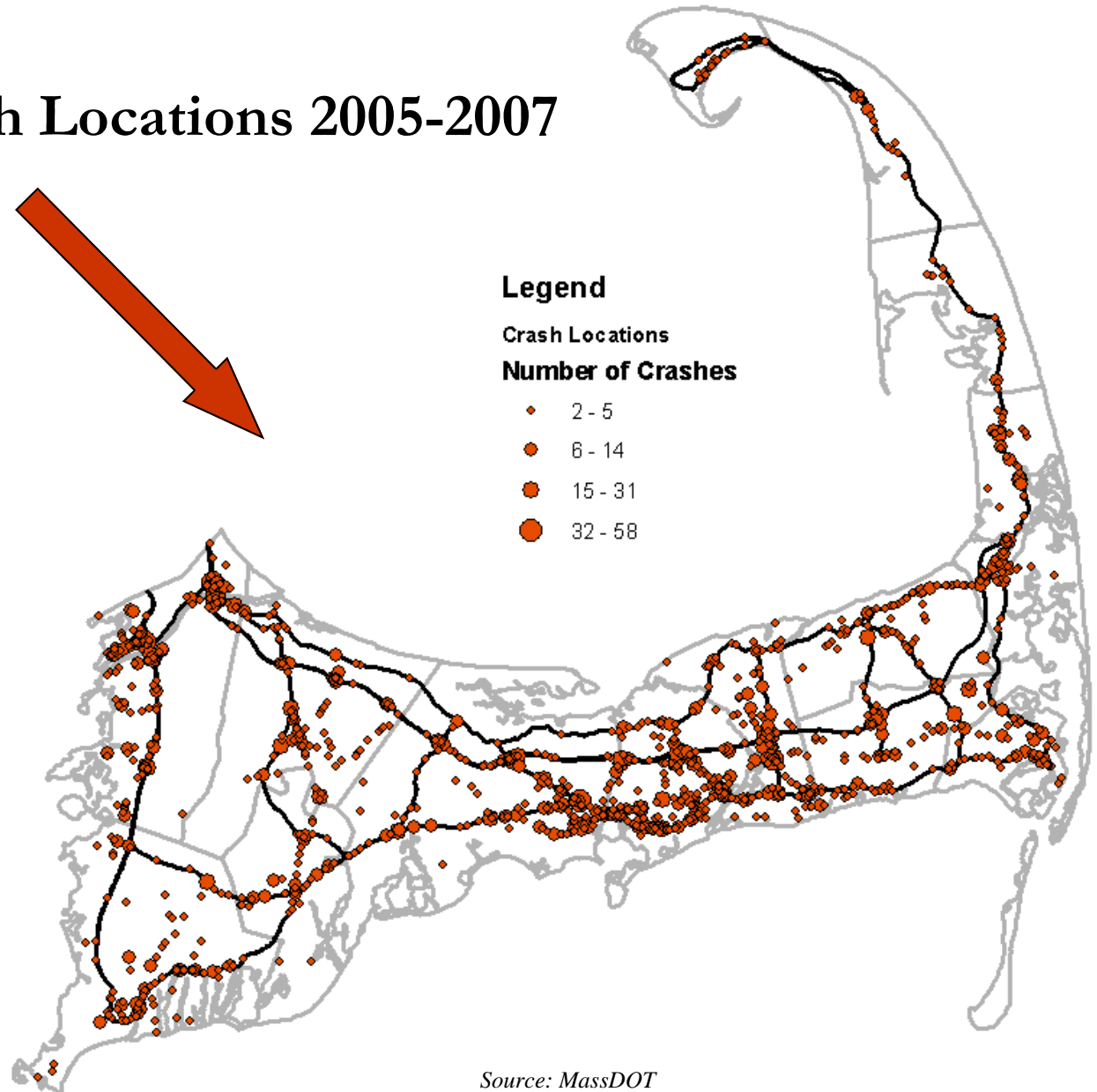
## Average Summer Weekday Canal Crossings

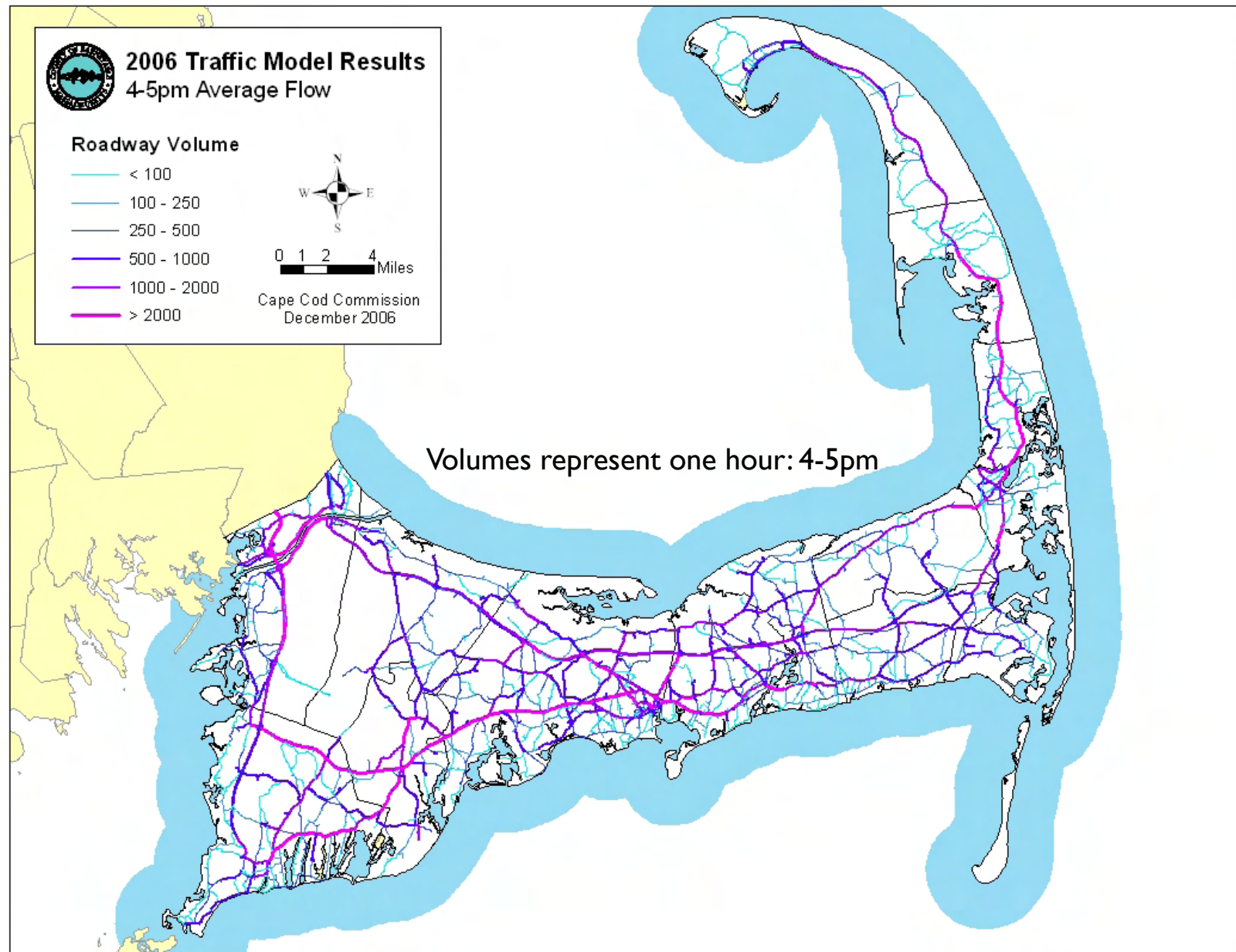

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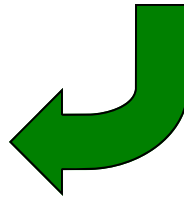
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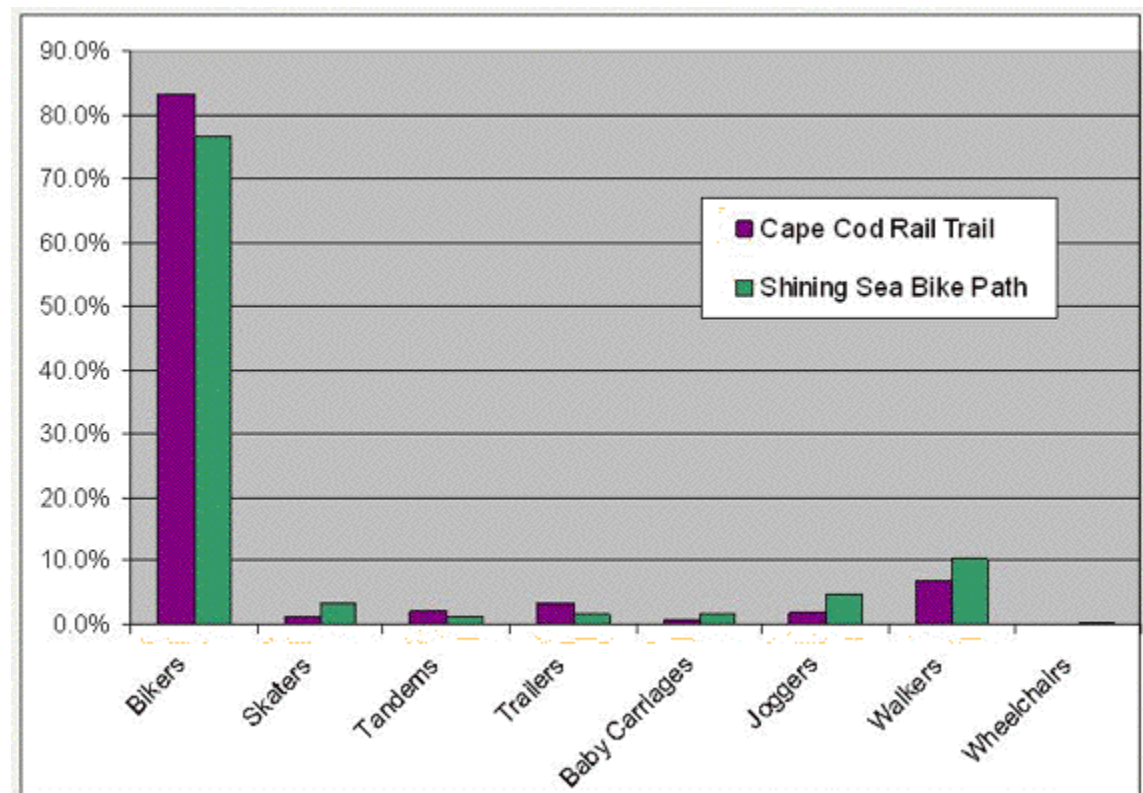


Shining Sea Bike Path in Falmouth, MA
