



DRI SUBCOMMITTEE MINUTES – CAPE COD COMMISSION

Monday, September 13, 2021 at 5:00 p.m. | Held via Zoom

The Chair, Stephen Mealy, opened the Development of Regional Impact (DRI) public meeting on the Bourne Integrated Solid Waste Management Facility (ISWMF) at 5:00 p.m. by reading the hearing notice and taking attendance by roll call:

The Chair asked for updates from Commission staff.

Commission Staff Updates

Jordan Velozo, of the Commission's Regulatory staff, began by clarifying the date to which the landfill could remain open without the DRI Approval from the Commission that was provided in the August 16th staff memo. Ms. Velozo said that the 2028 date provided by the Applicant is the correct date and the 2024 date and that staff memo is not correct. She also stated that the Applicant and Commission have mutually agreed to extend the hearing period until November 1, 2021. The last update is that the Commission received a public comment in support of the project this morning, which was distributed to subcommittee members and posted that to the website.

Ms. Velozo then reviewed the contents of the draft Decision, which is available to view on the Commission website.

Subcommittee Questions

The Chair then asked for questions from members of the subcommittee.

Ms. Taylor said that she has not changed her mind on her view of the application and the issues she has stated in earlier meetings stand.

Seeing no other questions or comments from members of the subcommittee, the Chair asked for comments from members of the public.

Seeing none, the Chair said that he would entertain a motion to recommend the draft Decision to the full Commission.

Mr. Wilson moved the motion as stated by the Chair. Ms. Brookshire seconded the motion.

Ms. Taylor asked if she could vote yes on the motion to send the Decision to the Commission without supporting the application.

Ms. Velozo said that the draft Decision is a Decision approving the Project so by voting to recommend it to the full Commission, Ms. Taylor would be supporting the application.

Hearing no other questions or discussion on the motion from members of the subcommittee the Chair took a roll call vote on the motion to send the draft DRI Decision to the Commission. The roll vote was as follows:
