### **TIP AMENDMENT 1 SUMMARY**

The TIP serves as a prioritized listing of roadway, bridge, and transit projects proposed for implementation during the next five (5) federal fiscal years. The FFY 2021-2025 TIP Amendment 1 would allocate \$12,528,731 in statewide TIP funds under FFY2021 for the Barnstable - Iyanough Road (Route 28) at Yarmouth Road Intersection Improvement Project (Project #606272). Work on this project consists of intersection reconstruction and traffic signal upgrades. The intent of the project is to improve safety and reduce congestion for all users. New rails, gates and signals will be installed for the rail crossing. A shared use path will be constructed on the west side of Yarmouth Road crossing at Route 28, then connecting to Engine House Road at the entrance to the intermodal center. The total project cost for this project is \$26,422,893.
