8. **Massachusetts Vulnerable User Roadway Signs for Municipalities:** Committee members will discuss their town's plans for coordinating and installing the new Vulnerable User Roadway signs that are being provided to municipalities on Cape Cod by MassDOT.
9. **Reports:** Massachusetts Department of Transportation staff will discuss the status of the Transportation Improvement Program projects. Cape Cod Regional Transit Authority and Cape Cod Commission staff will report on recent and upcoming transportation initiatives across Cape Cod.
