The TIP summarizes the regionally significant transportation infrastructure projects receiving federal funding for construction over the next five fiscal years.
- 9. 2025 Unified Planning Work Program ("UPWP") Study: Flashing Signal Beacon and Bicycle Rack Inventory Projects:** Staff will provide an overview of two inventory projects under the 2025 UPWP that will identify the locations of overhead flashing signal beacons and bicycle racks located on municipal properties across Cape Cod.
- 10. Cape Cod Vision Zero Safety Action Plan:** Staff will provide an update on the development of the Vision Zero Safety Action Plan, a comprehensive safety action plan to reduce and eliminate serious-injury and fatal motor vehicle crashes affecting all roadway users on Cape Cod.



11. Reports: Massachusetts Department of Transportation staff will discuss the status of the Transportation Improvement Program projects. Cape Cod Regional Transit Authority and Cape Cod Commission staff will report on recent and upcoming transportation initiatives across Cape Cod.
